**RE: PROPOSED VISIT TO KENYA BY BROTHER JEFF COMMUNITY
HEALTH INITIATIVE**


Brother Jeff Community Health Initiative was founded in 2000 by Jeff S. Fard in Denver Colorado, with the main aim of helping reduce the disproportionate HIV/AIDS rate among the African-American community in the U.S. The Initiative has worked with numerous organizations in the U.S. to help address the HIV/AIDS scourge in the U.S., youth issues, mental health, and drug abuse among others.
